SAFEGUARDING POLICY FOR CHILDREN

This is a simple guide for children to understand. It is about getting themselves to understand about keeping themselves safe and what to do if they feel they are not and need help and support.

Children remember the important thing to do is TELL someone!

Is someone bullying you?

You must tell someone at school so we can help you.

*Some people you can **TELL** in school are:*

Your Class Teacher or any adult working in school

Miss Lennon your Head Teacher or Mrs Orwin Assistant Head Teacher

TELL...TELL...TELL

Is someone saying odd or strange things to you?

Has someone said something to you that upsets you or have you heard something that you do not like?

*Some people you can **TELL** in school are:*

Your Class Teacher or Any adult working in school

Miss Lennon your Head Teacher or Mrs Orwin Assistant Head Teacher

TELL...TELL...TELL

Is someone touching you?

Has someone touched you and made you feel uncomfortable or has someone touched you somewhere where they shouldn't?

You must tell someone at school so we can help you.

*Some people you can **TELL** in school are:*

Your Class Teacher or any adult working in school

Miss Lennon your Head Teacher or Mrs Orwin Assistant Head Teacher

TELL...TELL...TELL

Is someone trying to give you tablets, cigarettes, drugs or alcohol?

Has someone asked you if you want a tablet or to smoke a cigarette, or have a drink of something and you do not know what it is?

Do not eat, drink or smoke what they are giving you.

You must tell someone at school so we can help you.

*Some people you can **TELL** in school are:*

Your Class Teacher or any adult working in school

Miss Lennon your Head Teacher or Mrs Orwin Assistant Head Teacher

TELL...TELL...TELL

Has someone hit, punched, smacked or hurt you?

Has someone hit, punched or smacked you or hurt you in any way?

You must tell someone at school so we can help you.

*Some people you can **TELL** in school are:*

Your Class Teacher or any adult working in school

Miss Lennon your Head Teacher or Mrs Orwin Assistant Head Teacher

**Has anyone sent you unkind messages or threatened you on your phone, I-Pad,
or other electronic device?**

Have you seen anything that has upset you or worried you?

**Has someone on-line asked you to do anything that made you feel
uncomfortable?**
