## Everybody Dance! (PE)

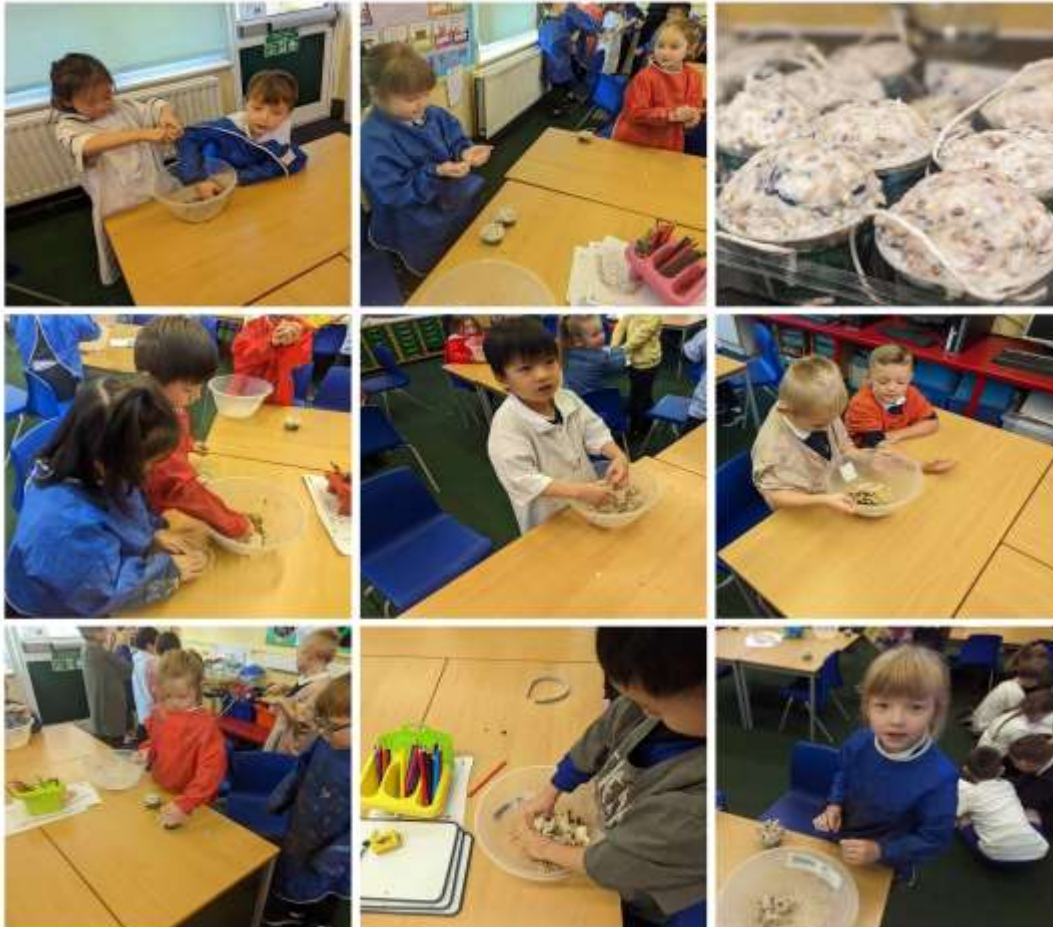
We started our dance topic in PE this week, with the children encouraged to think about how they were moving and what shapes and lines they could create with their bodies.
